

Public Disabled Toilet Key

Claim a ***RADAR (Royal Association for Disability and Rehabilitation)*** Disabled Toilet key from your local council offices (I paid £5, but different councils may have different prices or give it at no charge).

There are approximately 4,000 locked public disabled toilets, around the country, that can be used with this key. They are locked in order to prevent misuse and vandalism. The key has an extra wide head, in order to make it easy to turn for people that may find it difficult to turn keys.

There is also an economy normal sized key. I have also noticed advertisements for cheap keys (in either form) on the internet, by entering a Google search for "RADAR disabled toilet key".

As it is quite a big key (for those that have hand movement problems), please do not just go to a locksmith to get normal sized copies keys. It is a licensed key, which means that for every key that you buy from a ***RADAR*** licensed outlet, money is sent directly to ***RADAR*** to add to their valuable funds. These monies finance ***RADAR*** to help us. You can buy normal sized ***RADAR*** keys.

These are kept in my camper van, my main key ring, as well as on the same key ring as my electric scooter key. In that way, I should always be able to use a disabled toilet when I need to, regardless of whether I am on foot, scooter, campervan, or being transported by anybody else.

In procuring this key from your local authority, they may well require to see proof of you being registered disabled. Ownership and presentation of the previously mentioned yellow Registered Disabled Card will satisfy their request.
